The Turning Point Prize
Guidelines for Sponsoring Organizations

Every applicant for The Turning Point Prize must submit an application with a sponsoring educational institution with 501(c)(3) tax status or another 501(c)(3) not-for-profit tax-exempt organization. A letter from the sponsoring organization must be submitted with the application acknowledging its 501(c)(3) tax status, agreeing to take on the sponsorship role, and giving a general description of the types of support it will be providing the applicant.

This sponsoring organization will receive and administer the award. Expenditures will be restricted to those detailed in the application budget. The sponsoring organization will supervise the project, provide appropriate infrastructure to the project, act as a resource to the applicant and receive and disburse payments.

WOMEN'S WAY will distribute the cash award from the Women for Social Innovation Fund to the sponsoring organization, after receipt of an executed contract designating the purpose and terms of the award, which is as follows:

WW shall pay to the sponsoring organization up to 70% of the cash award at the time that the winning project is selected (or soon thereafter).

WW shall pay the balance of the cash award to the sponsoring organization after the 6-month progress report (as described below) is accepted by WSI and WW.

Reporting

The Turning Point Prize winner, in conjunction with his or her sponsoring organization, must submit to WSI and WW a 6-month progress report, and, within 90 days of project completion, must submit a final report comprised of a narrative describing project outcomes and a financial accounting report. All reports shall be presented as both a written document and an in-person presentation to Members.
